Kroger Community Reward Update



The annual participant re-enrollment for the Kroger Community Rewards will be during the entire month of August.

We are evaluating ways to make us more visible on the internet. This process is called Search Engine Optimization (SEO). For example, if you "Google" churches in Knoxville, we do not appear. If you "Google" churches in Farragut and Lenoir City, we do appear, but are towards the bottom of the list. Our goal is to be found when you Google Knoxville and to "move up" when searching Knoxville, Farragut and Lenoir City. We are considering purchasing this service from "Go Daddy" at a cost of about \$10 per month.
